PRINCIPAL REPORT

OV—Mr. Cline

- Mon June 5 had a joint event with Mr. Geiger and the NHE 2nd graders field trip to OV. 2nd graders received an overview and tour. They also crafted bookmarks and left with a Dragon backpack with a book and some parent information on reading with their child over the summer.
- Mon June 12 there will be an assembly at 9:10am for parents, volunteers and PTA staff. 13 parents that attended most of the Parent Coffee's will also be recognized. Additionally, each of the OV staff will be recognized.
- 5th grade promotion at 9:30am next week. There will be limited seating due to size of the gym area.
- Fri June 16 Staff Cookout after early dismissal on the last day of school
- MAP test ended today
- 2 portables will be added next year for our 5th graders. There were 422 students at OV when Mr. Cline began, and to date there are 475 registered for this Fall.
- 4 Highly Gifted and Talented classrooms next year, 2 4th grade classrooms and 2 5th grade classrooms
- All teacher positions are filled except for music teacher which is currently in the works
- 339 students had at least 1 club which has increased by 70 students in prior years. Mr. Cline thanked the PTA for help with sponsoring transportation for the clubs.
